The Big Paint, our largest craft venue, abounds with activities: snow globes and beads, baskets to weave, festival t-shirts to paint, masks and costumes to create. This and more is on offer every day – a treasure trove of things to make, create, play and do.

Follow the whisper and hear words of wisdom from the Magic Wishing Tree.

Stardust Theatre presents a range of performance and dance concerts and workshops. Join the renowned Mic Conway as Magic Mic, the legendary Alex and Annette Hood, and the irrepressible Mike Jackson. The Twine Family rocket onto the stage, Fractal Youth Theatre present Sleeping Beauty Down Under, while Intrika and the Masked Mime display their juggling theatre. Be ignited with the high-octane moves of the ZumbAtomic groove, and discover true Indian-style Bollywood with the Singh Sisters. And in a night-time first for the Children's Festival, The Recycled Cabaret present an eccentrically formal affair for the whole family.

The Puppet Joint is the black box of strings, hands and all things manipulated. Come and savour the pure nonsense of Professor Wallace's Puppet Theatre and then get involved in puppet making and performing workshops. Join Salty Pete's Pirate School and learn how to be a pirate in 5 easy lessons. Discover the art of cartooning in an unhinged sort of way, and then uncover your 'light bulb' moment. There is storytelling galore each day with tales that drift out of the tent and settle on shady branches. The Teddy Bears Breakfast promises food and frolics, so bring your furry friends.

Mish Mash is a specially-programmed venue for the pre-school age with loads of activities to keep the very young engaged. Workshops, dance, games, music and more will keep the smiles alive.

Run away and join the Circus Arts North crew at Circus Lair, where all manner of circus tricks and skills will be taught - for every circus fanatic.

Enter the world of Big Ideas and discover the life stories of the presenters in 'From Little Things'. Bush food cooking, environmental workshops and daily Uke'n Play Ukulele sessions are calling. And there is more! Be awakened each morning with Zenthai Shiatsu and Yoga for the family. Enjoy the good old Good Wood Workshop, and then join the Children's Festival procession orchestra in the Big Bang with Linsey Pollak.

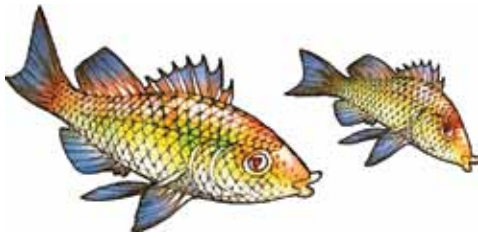

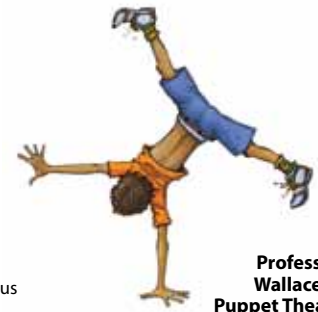

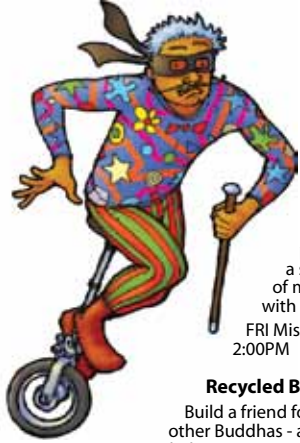
